Exclusive Rights of Burial (EROB)

As part of the provisions of the Local Authority Cemeteries Order 1977(LACO), the Burial Authority may grant to any person the EROB in any grave or grave space. The power to grant burial rights to individuals is contained under Article 10(1) of LACO. The Burial Authority may grant EROB on such terms and conditions as it thinks proper. The rights subsist for the period specified by the Authority.

The Burial Authority presently offers EROB in Vaults for a period of thirty years. The Rights are conferred to the purchaser via a formal document called the "Deed of Grant". The provisions of LACO prevents Exclusive Rights being granted in perpetuity, however the Burial Authority can renew the original EROB for another predetermined period once the original period has expired.

When a vault is purchased, the person making the purchase is purchasing the EROB for the use of that vault; they are not purchasing the actual plot of land or the vault facility. The grant of EROB does not convey any ownership of the land or the vault itself. The ownership of the cemetery land, including the vault remains the property of the Burial Authority.

By purchasing the EROB, the vault may not be opened, nor can anyone be interred in it without the owner's permission.

If the owner dies they have the right to be interred in the vault they owned. However no further interments, installation or amendment of an engraved memorial plaque can take place until the EROB for that vault has been legally transferred to a new owner.

At the end of this period the grave owner will be invited to renew the Exclusive Rights of Burial.

For this reason it is important to inform the cemetery office if the grave owner changes address.

If the rights are not renewed at the end of the term, the Exclusive Rights for the vault will return to Llanelli Joint Burial Authority. If this is the case the cremated remains will be removed from the vault and returned to the last registered grave owner.

If preferred, the cremated remains can be scattered in the specially developed remembrance gardens.



Each vault is manufactured from granite and is large enough to accept two standard size caskets. The internal shelf can be removed if a single larger casket or urn is preferred.

The front plaque is attached by specially designed security fixings. The plaque can be engraved, therefore providing a lasting memorial to the deceased.

The plaque must be engraved via the service offered by the cemetery office.

Only cemetery staff are permitted to install or remove a vault plaque.

The plaque can be engraved in advance of the interment if desired.
